The performances drew significant public attention and fostered a sense of collective reflection.

Several teams participated enthusiastically, presenting powerful themes with originality and conviction. After careful evaluation, Team TC 03 was declared the Winner for their performance on “Superstitions in India and Blind Faith in Spiritual Leaders.” The team effectively highlighted the dangers of irrational beliefs and blind devotion, emphasizing the importance of critical thinking and social reform. Their compelling narration, energetic coordination, and impactful acting deeply resonated with the audience. The winning team was awarded a cash prize of ₹3000 in recognition of their outstanding performance.

The Runners-up, Team TC 04, presented a thought-provoking play titled “Justice for All Voices.” Their performance focused on equality, inclusion, and the necessity of ensuring justice for marginalized and unheard communities. The team was widely appreciated for its emotional depth, clarity of message, and confident presentation. They were awarded a cash prize of ₹2000 for their commendable efforts.
