2. The Presiding Offr welcomed all the members. Progress on the points of the last meeting was given.

3. The following agenda points were discussed and deliberated upon were as under:-

AGENDA POINT 1

ACTION TOWARDS INCREASE IN THE INTAKE STRENGTH

Discussion. The point was discussed earlier and discussed again. Presently there is intake strength of 80 for BA LL.B 5-year course. There is always a demand by the stake holders for increase in the seats. Looking from the number of applicants registered i.e. 1132 for 64 seats in the session 2018-2019, it becomes clear that there is need to increase the intake strength from 80 to 100. Members were also of the view that since the college has established as a centre of legal education, there is a need to increase the intake strength.

Action Required. The detailed proposal for increase in intake was forwarded to the Management for approval. Action required is to take up the case with the Bar Council of India and Punjabi University, Patiala for admissions from the session 2020-21 for 100 seats.

AGENDA POINT 2

SPORTS FACILITIES AT 1.44 ACRE CAMPUS

Discussion. Since the first phase of the constr and grassing of the ground has been done, members were of the view that institute should work towards utilization of the ground for various sports and other activities.

Action Required. The grounds to be prepared for various sports events i.e. running tracks, putting up nets for different games. Committees to be detailed for different events that can be conducted apart from sports for the optimum utilization of 1.44 acre campus.

AGENDA POINT 3

HOLISTIC DEVELOPMENT OF STUDENTS

Discussion. For the holistic development of the students there is requirement to make efforts for the overall development of the students by conducting some activities along with the guest/expert lectures every Thursday.

Action Required. Based on the discussions, it has been recommended that a special 'Brain Storming Session' shall be conducted every week for 1st year to 3rd year students. These sessions shall be conducted on the current/relevant topics and latest Judgments. These sessions are to be conducted by 02 faculty members for each year and will be part of the Time Table in the next academic session of the respective classes.

AGENDA POINT 4

PREPARATION FOR THE NAAC PEER TEAM VISIT

Discussion. The institute was accredited Grade 'A' by NAAC in Jul 2014 which is valid for 5 years i.e. 09 Jul 2019. Members prepared the SSR which was forwarded and clarifications asked by NAAC have been duly answered. Based on this, three slots of dates of Peer Team visit were forwarded.

Action Required. The members suggested that Institute should be ready for the Peer Team visit in terms of documentation, maintenance of the campus, infrastructure and other requirements for the visit.

AGENDA POINT 5

CONDUCT OF AIL-SURANA FAMILY LAW MOOT COURT COMPETITION

Discussion. AIL conducts a yearly National Moot Court Competition 'Checkmate'. After due discussions, a proposal was fwd to Surana & Surana Int'l

Attorneys who conducts the 15-16 Moot Court Competitions in the various national Law colleges/universities. The proposal has been accepted by the firm and dates have been finalized.

Action Required. Since the proposal has been accepted, the Institute to constitute committees to work towards the smooth conduct of the 1st AIL-Surana & Surana Moot Court Competition as per the terms & conditions given in the proposal.

AGENDA POINT 6

RENOVATION OF THE CAMPUS

Discussion. The building of the institute is 16 years old. Steps need to be taken to maintain the academic block and hostels where-ever required. Along with the annual maintenance, renovation also needs to be done with the changing requirements of the students like upgradation and air cooling of the Dining Halls.

Action Required. The point was discussed in details about the renovation. It was decided that messes to be renovated aesthetically and needs to be air-conditioned /air cooled looking at the weather conditions of the region.
